Road Scholar II



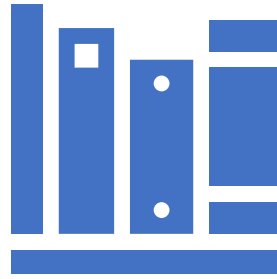
- Geared toward managers, supervisors, technician, planners, and engineers

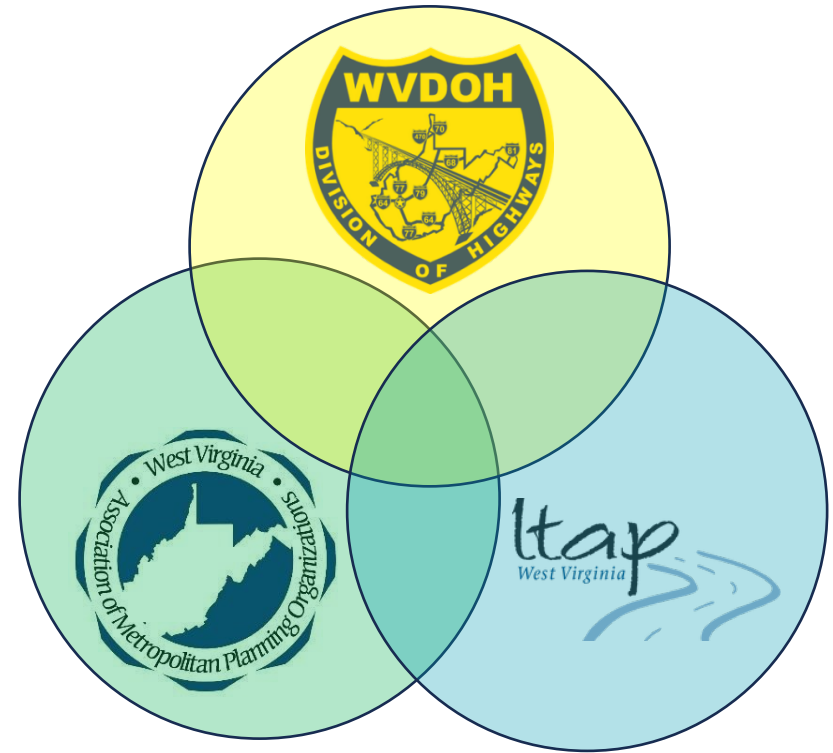

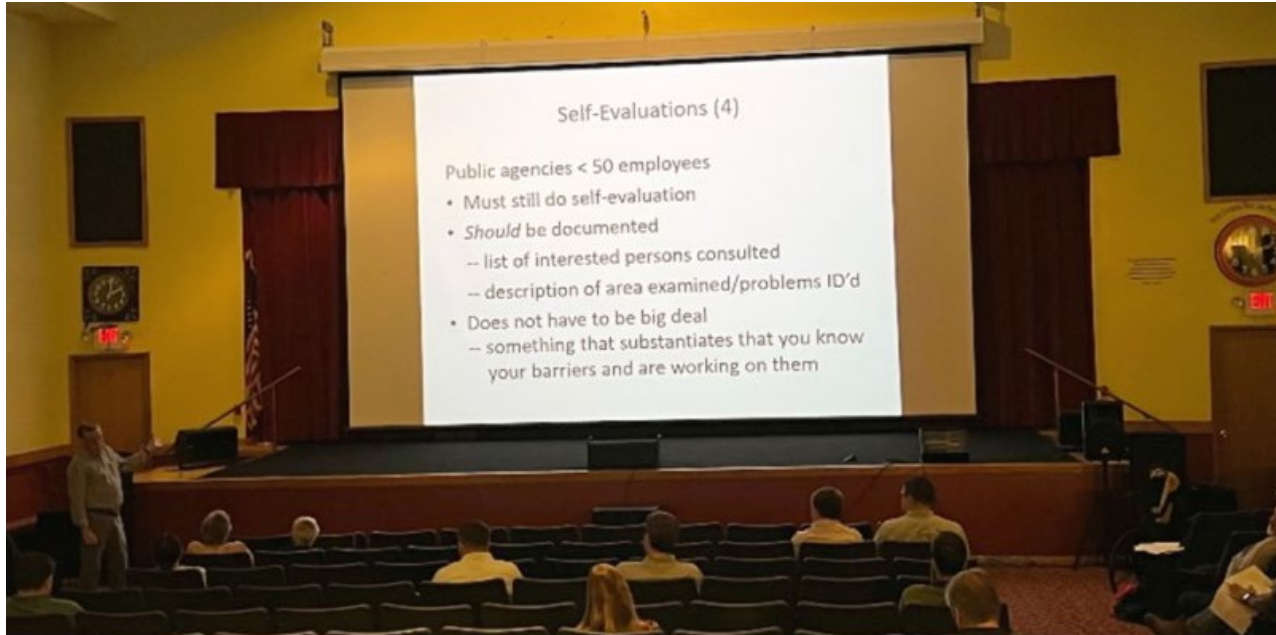
